TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY: Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Berrien County Highway Engineer, under statute, can regulate truck traffic on roads under the Road Department's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, in the 90's, "No Thru Trucks" signs were posted on a portion of Jericho Road in Lincoln Township and on a portion of Fairland Road in Berrien Township due to deteriorating road conditions; and

WHEREAS, the signage is located on Jericho Road from Johnson Road to Linco Road and was put in place in January of 1998; and

WHEREAS, the signage is located on Fairland Road from M-139 to M-140 and was put in place in August of 1991; and

WHEREAS, after a review of No Thru Truck signage placement, it was determined that the signage is no longer necessary on these two roads due to road improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Berrien County Highway Engineer recommends that the Board of Commissioners officially rescinds the "No Thru Trucks" resolutions for Jericho Road and Fairland Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners hereby rescinds the No Thru Truck resolutions for Fairland Road from M-139 to M-140 in Berrien Township dated August 30, 1991 and for Jericho Road from Johnson Road to Linco Road in Lincoln Township dated January 21, 1998 and authorizes the removal of the "No Thru Trucks" signage from the named roads as described above.
